The Board of Education and the Kelowna Fire Department recognized Chad Reid (Teacher Teaching on Call) and Aaron Volk (Teacher – Rutland Senior Secondary School) for their quick response to a fire that took place at Rutland Senior Secondary School.

#### **Action Items:**

#### 1. Superintendent's Mid-Year Report on Student Achievement 2012-2013

The Superintendent emphasized that we continue to be an improving District with a multi-year trendline demonstrating improved achievement results, especially in the following areas:

- **Early Learning** reduction of Aboriginal/non-Aboriginal primary students at-risk by the end of grade 3 (from 16% of primary students at-risk in 2009 to 11% in 2012)
- Increased **Graduation Rates** for all students (from 82.9% in 2009 to 86.5% in 2012)
- Increased **Aboriginal Graduation Rates** (from 55.3% in 2009 to 68.9% in 2012)
- Grade 10 **Participation in Career Preparation** (CP) Program Experiences (25% in 2009 to 60% in 2012)

The Superintendent also recognized challenging areas for the District which include:

- The grade readiness (measured by those students who pass all of their core courses within the appropriate grade) and graduation rates for Aboriginal students remain below the District target.
- The overall report card data shows concern for moving more students from minimally meeting expectations to fully meeting expectations

- Grade readiness data at the grade 10 level has dropped which requires further study and intervention
- There continues to be **concern about providing enough support for children in care** to ensure their success in school

The Board of Education approved the Superintendent's Mid-Year Report on Student Achievement 2012-2013. The complete report will be posted to the District's website and forwarded to the Ministry of Education to meet its January 31, 2013 deadline.

- 1. Superintendent's Emergent Items:
  - 4<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Parents are encouraged to register Kindergarten and new students during this registration period. It is anticipated that both Davidson Road Elementary and Chute Lake Elementary will be over capacity in the coming year, resulting in several catchment area students being directed to the nearest available school to accommodate them. Based on this, parents of incoming Kindergarten students and others new to the school, are advised that space is made available on a 'first come, first served' basis, with the parents who register at the beginning of the registration period having the greatest chance of gaining access to the school for their children.
