Action Items:

1. Westside Middle School French Immersion Program

The Board of Education approved the following Motion:

THAT: The Board of Education strike a Task Force to review options to guide future plans for the French Immersion Program;

AND THAT: The Task Force bring recommendations forward as to the process to be followed for the public consultation to the General Affairs Committee by October 7, 2015.

2. Lake Country Elementary School Catchment Area Review

Trustees made the decision to forward the topic of the Lake Country Elementary School Catchment Area Review to the Coordinating Committee of the Board for further direction. In the interim, for the 2015-2016 school year, no change will be made to the existing catchment areas in Lake Country. Students from the Davidson Road Elementary School catchment area who are unable to gain access to that school due to capacity issues will be redirected to Peter Greer Elementary School.

3. Central School Programs Building – Heritage Award

The Board of Education approved the placement of the Heritage BC Awards Plaque by school staff in the most appropriate location within the school facility.

4. Amended Annual Budget Fiscal Year 2014/2015

The Board of Education gave first, second and third readings, passed and adopted, the School District No. 23 (Central Okanagan) Amended Annual Budget Bylaw for 2014/2015 in the amount of \$214,432,053.

5. District Strike Savings Calculation

The Board of Education agreed to write a letter to the Ministry expressing disappointment regarding the lack of reimbursement by the Ministry for strike costs incurred by school districts, and stating that it would have been more beneficial to have the provincial strike savings reinvested into the education system rather than being used to provide the \$40/day fund for parents during the strike.
