1. 2020/2021 Annual Budget Bylaw

The Board of Education gave first, second and third readings, passed and adopted, the School District No. 23 (Central Okanagan) Annual Budget Bylaw for the Fiscal year 2020/2021 in the amount of \$284,166,432.

2. Systemic Racism Discussion/Action

The Board of Education agreed to put in place a process to assess and support education throughout the School District regarding systemic racism; anti-racist education; and historic and contemporary content by and about Black, Indigenous and People of Colour.
