#### 1. French Immersion Review

The Board of Education approved the following:

THAT: Students registered in Grade 6 French Immersion at École Glenmore and École Peter Greer move to Grade 7 French Immersion at Dr. Knox Middle School in September 2017.

THAT: Students registered in Grade 6 English program at A.S. Matheson Elementary School move on to Grade 7 English Program at KLO Middle School.

THAT: The Board of Education defer the decision for middle or late French immersion in West Kelowna until after a public Consultation;

AND THAT: The decision be made at or before the second Board of Education meeting in late January 2017.
