1. Balanced School Calendar Report

3. Board Direction to the BCSTA Provincial Councillor

The Board of Education provided direction to the trustee representing it at the upcoming BCSTA Provincial Council meeting. A motion was passed supporting the BCSTA Bargaining Structure Task Force Report in principle, with the recommendation that the proposed Bargaining Representative Council Box be removed from the report. It was also recommended that any Bargaining commitments be fully funded by the government. Furthermore, all costs related to BCSTA assuming any roles formerly conducted by BCPSEA, be fully funded by the government.

Information Items:

1. Superintendent's Emergent Issues

- The Superintendent reported that the District has now received 195 responses to the on-line survey on the proposed Westside catchment areas. Staff is now following up on the feedback received from the Public Consultation meetings and the on-line survey results. As a result of the feedback received, staff will also be contacting specific cohort groups for more information. Recommendations will be forthcoming prior to Friday, November 15, 2013. These recommendations will be posted on the School District website and will be further discussed at the Wednesday, November 20, 2013 Planning and Facilities Committee meeting at Mount Boucherie Secondary School at 6:00 p.m.
- The Superintendent also recognized staff, students, and parents who were involved in WE DAY Vancouver. Over 600 students represented the Central Okanagan School District at this event.
