2. New Policy 421 – Sanctuary Schools

The Board of Education approved new Policy 421 – Sanctuary Schools. The Policy states:

- 1.1 All school age children who are ordinarily resident in the school district, including those with precarious immigration status or no immigration status in Canada, are entitled to admission to school.
- 1.2 The personal information of enrolled students or their families shall not be shared with federal immigration authorities unless required by law.
- 1.3 The Board of Education shall not permit Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) officials or immigration authorities to enter schools or Board facilities unless required by law.
