5. Enhancement Agreement - Rose Valley Elementary School

The Board of Education agreed to enter into an Enhancement Agreement with the Rose Valley Elementary School PAC for the creation of a GaGa Ball Court.

6. Trustee Indemnity for the 2018/2019 Fiscal Year

The Board of Education agreed to set the Trustee Indemnity, in accordance with the most recent BC Consumer Price Index of 2.1%, for the period effective July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 thereby setting the salaries at:

- The **Firefighting Bootcamp 2018** conference was held last week at the Firehall on Enterprise. The conference provided students with hands-on experience with a number of firefighting responsibilities. Appreciation was expressed to the Kelowna Fire Department for arranging this amazing opportunity for students.
