## Central Okanagan Public Schools – "Inside 23"

A video of the project was presented.

This mural project was inspired by a wish to reflect on the past year through a positive lens and bring the community together – even as everyone continued to be distanced from each other. The students and staff at École Dorothea Walker Elementary School chose to document their resilience and find beauty and strength where there was challenge, fear and uncertainty. The project itself is a collage which began with each class recording their messages in text. Layers of material were added in stages so that every child and adult had a hand somewhere in the finished piece. The edges of each section are intentionally overlapped to indicate the connectedness through community.

Trustees spoke of their attendance at the Central Okanagan Parent Advisory Council Meeting AGM and District Student Council Meeting. The Board Chairperson spoke of the following:

1. A letter was recently received by the Board of Education from Central Okanagan Principals' and Vice-Principals' Association President, Scott Sieben, expressing appreciation to Superintendent of Schools/CEO Kevin Kaardal and Executive Director of Human Resources Bob McEwen for "going above and beyond to ensure that all staff members who wished to be vaccinated were assigned a time. It was a tremendous organizational accomplishment". The COPVPA further commended members of the Central Okanagan Teachers' Association who collaborated to provide coverage for their colleagues to ensure the process of the vaccination of staff went smoothly.

The Board Chairperson stated that Mr. Kaardal and Mr. McEwen would want their teams recognized for their hard work. She also commended Principals and Vice-Principals for their leadership in working with their school staff and for their hard work over the past year.
