### 1. Canadian Student Leadership Conference (CSLC) 2014 – Update

Derek Lea, Principal of George Elliot Secondary School and member of the CSLC 2014 Steering Committee, and KSS leadership student, Aidan Lea, provided information on past Canadian Student Leadership Conferences as well as an update on various events that are being planned for the upcoming Canadian Student Leadership Conference, hosted by the Central Okanagan School District, in September 2014.

# 1. Capital Project Bylaw No. 126691, Carbon Neutral Capital Program (CNCP) 2014/2015

The Board of Education gave first, second and third readings, passed and adopted School District No. 23 Capital Project Bylaw No. 126691 – Carbon Neutral Capital Program (CNCP) – 2014/2015 in the amount of \$219,553.

#### 2. Westside Middle School French Immersion Program

The Board of Education approved that consideration of the establishment of a French Immersion Program on the Westside to commence in September of 2015 be added to the staff Workplan for 2014/2015, and that the Workplan also include a study of the French Immersion enrolment patterns and facility requirements at École KLO Middle School.

3. Draft Board Correspondence to the Minister of Education Regarding the Expectation that Districts Will Use Any Surplus Funds to Share the Cost of Capital Projects, and Expressing Concern Regarding Public Education Funding

The Board of Education agreed to send a letter to the Minister of Education regarding the expectation that School Districts will use any surplus funds to share the cost of Capital Projects, and expressing concern regarding public education funding.
