### 2. BACKGROUND

At the first Public Board Meeting of the year held on September 14, 2016, general information was provided for the time period of September 6 through 9, 2016. As there have been additional adjustments and refinements since September 9, 2016, it was agreed that Part 2 of the School Opening Report would be provided to the Board on September 28, 2016.

## **District Enrolment Trends**

Overall, District enrolment has increased by 563 students over last year. We currently have 22,207 students. The differences between this year and last year are as follows:

- Secondary schools are 141 students over their projected enrolment, and they have 120 more students than they had by September 30, 2015.
- Middle schools are 14 students under their projected enrolment, and they have 4 less students than they had by September 30, 2015.
- Elementary schools are 137 students over their projected enrolment, and 323 more students than they had in September of 2015.
- Alternate student enrolment is currently 515 students compared to 391 students for the same time last year. However, this number is expected to increase prior to the provincial enrolment count of September 30, 2016.

Appendix 1 provides a detailed analysis of the change in enrolment by individual school, level and zone between last year and this year.
