## National Child Day - Sunday, November 20, 2016

The Central Okanagan Board of Education declared Sunday, November 20, 2016 as "National Child Day" in Central Okanagan Public Schools.

#### **Action Items:**

1. Request from the District Human Rights Committee – British Columbia Human Rights Code
The Board of Education approved that single use washrooms (or alternate washroom facilities) that
exist in the District be more accessible by changing signage from gender specific "Male" and "Female"
to gender neutral "Washroom" for these single use facilities. The Board of Education agreed to make
the requirements of the Human Rights Code and the needs of all students in regard to washroom
facilities a priority for action as funding comes available for retrofitting, renovating, and designing
washrooms in existing and new facilities. District staff will provide a plan to the Board of Education

at a future Planning and Facilities Committee Meeting outlining the process to enact the two Motions approved by the Board.

# **Superintendent's Emergent Issues:**

The District is currently in a stage of heightened awareness due to the tragedy at Abbotsford Senior Secondary School. Over the past couple of weeks there have been several incidents in the Central Okanagan involving the RCMP resulting in a letter sent home to parents/guardians encouraging them to review the RCMP Street Proofing Tips with their children.

## **Pro-Active Safety Awareness**

The Board of Education received a presentation by Dave Cavezza, District Health & Safety Manager, on the safety procedures currently existing in the Central Okanagan School District. The District's Safety and Emergency Response Protocols were reviewed by senior staff at a Leadership Meeting this week.
