Guest artists, such as Lee Claremont and Smoker Marchand, have contributed greatly to the students understanding of the history and cultural teachings associated with First Nations artwork. Students shared how they have been inspired by Mr. Elwood and guest artists. The students shared their artwork which included the sanding, shaping, and painting of paddles.
