In the end, judges added a fourth-place winner due to the high quality of all the presentations and emerging businesses. The winners were:

2nd Place (\$2000) – Creator Castle, Noah Garcia (OKM)

4th Place (\$500) – Gutter Guys, Kylan Urban & David Ross (Mount Boucherie Secondary)
