#### 1. Draft Achievement Contract 2014/2015

The Board of Education approved the 2014/2015 Achievement Contract. The Achievement Contract will be forwarded to the Ministry of Education by the July 15, 2014 deadline.

The Board of Education approved the Recommended School-Based CommunityLINK Allocations for the 2014-2015 school year. These funds support vulnerable students through a variety of initiatives, including the provision of a 'brown-bag' lunch program.

# 6. Ministry Early Learning Transfer Under Agreement

The School District receives Ministry funding to operate eight StrongStart Centres at the following locations: A.S. Matheson Elementary, Raymer Elementary, George Pringle Elementary, Hudson Road Elementary, Pearson Road Elementary, South Rutland Elementary, Peter Greer Elementary and Peachland Elementary Schools. The Board of Education approved the new Early Learning Transfer Under Agreement with the Ministry of Education, which provides the District with the necessary funding to maintain the eight StrongStart Centres, plus funding for Ready, Set, Learn initiatives.
