The Central Okanagan Board of Education acknowledged that this meeting was held on the Traditional Territory of the Okanagan People.

Recognition:

1. School District No. 23 Science Fair – March 2015

The Board of Education recognized Teryl Bates, a grade 7 student at Dr. Knox Middle School, as the recipient of the Marlon Brown "Best in Fair" Award at the School District No. 23 Science Fair held in March of 2015.

Declaration:

1. "National Volunteer Week – April 12-18, 2015"

The Central Okanagan Board of Education declared April 12 to 18, 2015 as National Volunteer Week and recognizes all volunteers in the Central Okanagan School District.

2. "National Day of Mourning – April 28, 2015"

The Central Okanagan Board of Education declared April 28, 2015 as a Day of Mourning in the Central Okanagan School District and observed a moment of silence to honour those workers who have been hurt or who have lost their lives in the course of performing their work duties.
