

BOARD OF EDUCATION BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

School District No. 23 (Central Okanagan)

Date: Wednesday, January 22, 2014

Declaration:

1. Harmony Day and Human Rights Month – 2014

Moyra Baxter, Chairperson of the Board of Education, made the following declaration:

WHEREAS: Harmony Day recognizes that the citizens of the Central Okanagan come from all

over the world; and,

WHEREAS: Harmony Day provides an annual opportunity for the Central Okanagan School

District community to celebrate cultural diversity while committing to mutual respect;

and,

WHEREAS: Harmony Day creates sensitivity to and respect for differences; and

WHEREAS: Harmony Day allows the Central Okanagan School District to focus on the mission

of educating students in a safe, inspirational learning environment; and,

THEREFORE: I, Moyra Baxter, as Chairperson of the Board of Education of School District No. 23

(Central Okanagan), do hereby proclaim February 5, 2014 as Harmony Day in the

Central Okanagan School District;

and also do hereby proclaim the month of February 2014 as Human Rights Month

in the Central Okanagan School District.

2. School Bus Safety Week – February 2 through to February 7, 2014

Moyra Baxter, Chairperson of the Board of Education, declared February 2 through to February 7, 2014 as "School Bus Safety Week" in the Central Okanagan School District, supporting the theme "Be Smart – Be Seen, I Wait in a Safety Place".

3. Eric Neilson Day - February 6, 2014 as proclaimed by the Central Okanagan School District and the City of Kelowna

Moyra Baxter, Chairperson of the Board of Education, made the following proclamation:

I, Moyra Baxter, as Chairperson of the Board of Education of School District No. 23, do hereby proclaim February 6, 2014 as Eric Neilson Day in the Central Okanagan School District.

(Eric Neilson, selected as a member of the 2014 Canadian Olympic Team, was raised in Kelowna and attended Central Okanagan School District schools, graduating from Rutland Senior Secondary in 1999. Rutland Middle School students are currently engaged in school-wide projects in support of Eric Neilson's Olympic effort.)

Action Items:

1. Renewal of Special Program for Positions in the Aboriginal Education Program

The Board of Education approved the application for renewal and expansion of the Special Program with the British Columbia Human Rights Tribunal for positions in the Aboriginal Education Program, and directed staff to include in all advertisements for teaching positions that preference may be given to applicants with Aboriginal ancestry.

2. BC Hydro Statutory Right-of-Way for Mar Jok Elementary School

The Board of Education gave first, second and third readings, and adopted School District No. 23 (Central Okanagan) Property Bylaw No. 126 (registration of a Statutory Right-of-Way) in favour of BC Hydro on Lot 35, District Lot 503, Osoyoos Division Yale District, Plan KAP73555 Except Plan EPP27929.
