BOARD OF EDUCATION SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETING BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Date: Wednesday, July 16, 2014

Action Items:

1. School District No. 23 (Central Okanagan) Bylaw No. 16 – Election 2014

The Board of Education read a third and final time, passed and adopted School District No. 23 (Central Okanagan) Bylaw No. 16 – Election 2014. This Bylaw establishes the process to be followed for the upcoming election of trustees for the future Board of Education, which will now serve a four year term.

2. Superintendent Emergent Items

The Superintendent advised the Board that the current provincial labour dispute is ongoing and there are no significant updates at this time. Considering the possibility that the new school year may begin with job action still taking place, the importance of developing contingency plans for the following was discussed:

- **International Education**

The District is preparing for the arrival of 250 International students. In honouring the commitments that have been made to these students and their families, District staff is engaged in preliminary planning of alternate programming.

- **Canadian Student Leadership Conference (CSLC) – September 23-27, 2014**

The District is engaging in dialogue with partnership groups regarding the challenges that may be associated with running this large national conference if the labour dispute continues.
